Commissioner Mohr would like to see City employees more involved in discussion/events to reach out to the community and have more educational/information campaigns. Commissioner Mohr informed the Commission on Know your rights event at Midnight Records.

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Commissioner Montañez commented that the streetlights at Fox/Truman and other locations are out.

By consensus, the Commission would like to add the following item to a future meeting. Information on Streetlights throughout the City (Briefing Staff report for calendar year 2025 to include mechanisms outages, timeframe to get lights replaced, maintenance schedule, which ones are Edison/City, how often things are down, types of lights used, etc.).

Commissioner Z. Rodriguez supports Commissioner Mohr's comments. Commissioner Z. Rodriguez commented on the three tiers of traffic: Engineering, education and enforcements and would like to focus on the first two.

Vice Chair Cuellar made the following comments: green means go, yellow means slow down and red means stop. Don't go through a red light.
